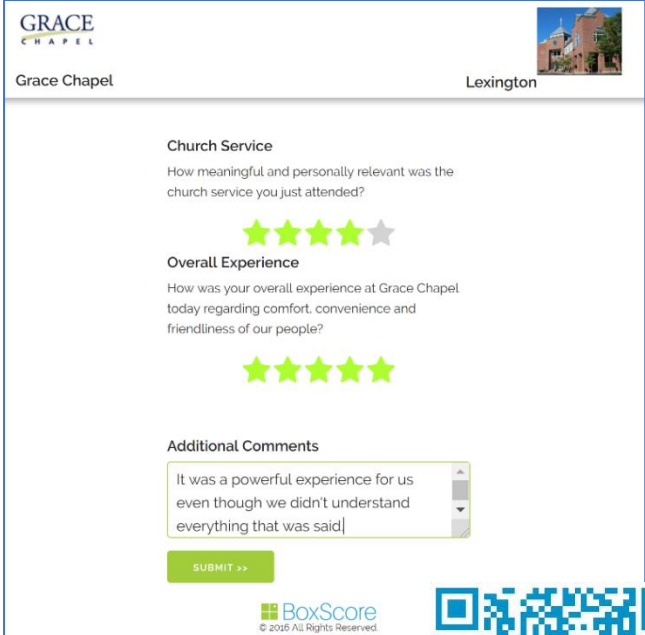


BoxScore – For Churches

How does it work?

BoxScore captures real-time feedback already in people's heads - in under 30 seconds.
